

MEASURES TO REDUCE THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USERS

ACCORDING TO UNE 0066-15:2020

The reopening of yachting facilities also calls for the collaboration of the users, so we recommend the following basic safety guidelines:

- Before entering the yachting facilities to carry out the appropriate activity, please contact reception to find out whether there are any requirements or conditions regarding access, capacity limits or access restrictions.
- Please plan your transfer from your destination to the yachting facility so you can sail directly, whenever possible and without intermediate stops, thereby minimising the risks of infection.
- Once at the yachting facility, please respect the social distancing requirements with other users and staff.
- Please communicate with the yachting facility staff by phone, VHF or email in order to minimise personal contact.
- Please respect social distancing and avoid touching any surfaces, such as walls, reception desks or doors, etc., when entering customer service offices.
- Wash your hands frequently, especially if you may have touched a surface (reception desk, steering mechanism, etc.) and you are going somewhere else, such as your yacht.
- Make sure you have enough sanitising material on board to disinfect your hands and the most exposed surfaces of the yacht.
- If you wish to set sail, please try to stay at the yachting facility for the shortest possible time, organising your departure well so that you can leave as quickly as possible. Please inform the yachting facility staff of your sailing plans. If fuel supply is required, please plan in advance and check with the fuel station or supplier beforehand about the opening hours and conditions of access, as yachts are not allowed to wait by the fuel dock.
- Please do not approach other yachts, boats and floating devices and always maintain the safety distance once you are underway.
- Please check in advance with the authorities whether there are restrictions or limitations of use and access at your destination (beaches, other yachting facilities, etc.).
